- Focus on a task for a period ranging from 15 to 30 minutes for Kindergarten through 2nd and 20 to 45 minutes for 3rd through 6th grades.
- Sit for a period of 20 minutes for Kindergarten through 2nd and 30 to 40 minutes for 3rd through 6th grades.
- Contribute verbally to class discussions in a way that is not disruptive.
- Maintain an average grade of 85 or above.
- Read books at a grade appropriate level.
- Perform mathematic calculations at a grade appropriate level.
- Communicate in writing at a grade appropriate level.
- Participate in a Science Lab in 5th and 6th grades.
