**Course Description:** This class is designed to equip students with a working knowledge of the Old Testament (OT). Since the scope of the Old Testament is so broad, this class will be more of a survey than an in-depth analysis of the sacred text.

### Course Objectives:

1. To understand the historical chronology of the Old Testament.
2. To become familiar with the major theological themes of the OT in their historical context.
3. To understand how OT laws, regulations and practices relate (if at all) to believers in the New Covenant era.

### Course Requirements:

1. Students must *diligently* read assigned OT texts. Although students will not be reading the entire OT text, we will cover large portions each week. Be prepared.
2. Students will be required to give a class presentation on an Old Testament book.
3. Students will be required to participate in class discussions and share their thoughts on the various issues that are raised during the meeting time.
