

MCA Dual Enrollment 2025–2026 Overview

This guide outlines the Midland Classical Academy (MCA) aligned dual enrollment courses offered in partnership with Christian Halls International (CHI) and Southeastern University (SEU). These courses are designed to align with specific MCA tutorials, helping students integrate their MCA curriculum with regionally accredited college credit opportunities.

MCA Aligned Courses

The SEU courses are assessment-based¹ and are integrated with the MCA tutorial curriculum. When students complete their assigned MCA coursework and tutorials, they will have everything they need to fulfill the SEU assessment course requirements.

¹ Assessment is where students will select one of the provided prompts and submit artifacts of learning (essay, presentation, or slide deck) to demonstrate mastery of the intended learning outcomes at a college level. These assessments will be graded by SEU professors, and sufficient feedback will be provided to justify the grade assigned to each assessment.

Enrollment Instructions

Step 1: Join Christian Halls (MyHall Platform)

- Visit: <https://portal.christianhalls.org>
- Create a student profile → Search for “MCA Hall”
- Request to join the hall
- Once admitted to hall, enroll in desired tutorials
- CHI staff reviews tutorial requests and submits course registration to SEU

Step 2: Apply to SEU (can be done at the same time as Step 1)

- Go to: <https://seu.edu/admission/apply/edi/#apply>
- Select Dual Enrollment > Apply Now
- Click “Start Application”
- Click “EDI / Christian Halls (Dual)”
- Fill out the application form and select Midland Classical Academy as your location
- Receive acceptance email (24–48 hrs)
